BUDGET CALENDAR PROCESS**

The following are important upcoming dates related to the development of the Lebanon Public Schools budget. As this again will be a most challenging year, I am sending this information to encourage your participation in the process. The Board of Education will develop a zero percent increase or "flat budget" as requested by the Board of Finance in order to demonstrate the context of the reductions to meet this expectation.

February 9 – Lyman Memorial High School, 7:30 PM: Board of Education discussion of reductions to reach a zero percent increase.

February 18 – Lyman Memorial High School, 7:30 PM: Board of Education budget discussion continued.

February 23 – Lyman Memorial High School, 7:30 PM: Board of Education vote on the 2010-2011 budget to present to the Board of Finance.

March 6 – Fire Safety Complex, 9:00 AM: Board of Finance Public Hearing on the Board of Education budget (and other town budgets).

March 16- Town Hall, 7:30 PM: Board of Finance Public Hearing Capital Reserve and Non-Recurring Expenses.

March 25 – Town Hall, 7:30 PM: Board of Finance Special Meeting to review the Board of Education budget.


